Dear Aldersgate,

We are having a church-wide informational meeting on Sunday, March 12, 2023 at 12:30 pm. Lunch will be provided. We are making sure that the meal will allow everyone to be present for the meeting. Therefore, we <u>need</u> for you to sign up in advance. Please sign up no later than <u>Wednesday, March 8, 2023</u>.

During the information session, we will provide a brief update on opportunities to our share space with others. However, the focus of the discussion will be on the "Local Church Discernment Process". This is the plan that the Trustees of the South Carolina Annual Conference have provided for churches seeking to separate from the United Methodist Church and retain the property.

This plan was published at the end of December 2022 to address congregations that wanted to leave the United Methodist church over the language and upholding of the language regarding homosexuality in *The Book of Discipline* (2016) with amendments and additions from General Conference 2019. This issue has been debated at every General Conference since 1972. Some churches, particularly ones that do not want the language changed have decided it is time to leave and become independent churches or join another denomination.

The South Carolina Conference has determined that the churches seeking to leave do not meet the standards in ¶2553 that was written for churches that cannot accept the language regarding homosexuality. This paragraph is only effective through the end of 2023. The South Carolina Conference is using the process in ¶2549. Therefore, the "Local Church Discernment Process" does not have an end date. Instead, it has a yearly deadline of March 1 in order to be on the agenda for Annual Conference in June of each year. The "Local Church Discernment Process" requires a minimum 30 day discernment period, and the meeting of financial obligations.

We discussed the "Local Church Discernment Plan" and the structure of the United Methodist Church at the Leadership Launch on Saturday, January 21, 2023. The consensus of the leadership was to wait and see what happens because the language in *The Book of Discipline* regarding the church's stance that homosexuality "is incompatible with Christian teaching" (¶161) and not ordaining ministers who are openly, practicing homosexuals has not changed.

Many of you heard about other congregations that were having church conferences in February and voting to leave the United Methodist Church. This process has raised many new questions. Mark Sari and I will explain the process and try to answer your questions during this informational meeting. In order to be able to answer your questions and to <u>present information with supporting sources</u>, we would appreciate questions submitted before the meeting.

I would also welcome your questions and comments in a Lenten discussion based on "Bless the Lent We <u>Actually</u> Have". I'll be in the Parlor at noon on Tuesdays.
