#### **Lent Is Coming**

Lent is the season of preparation before Easter. It lasts 40 days, beginning on Ash Wednesday and ending with Holy Saturday (not including Sundays). From the time of the early church, Lent was considered a time of prayer and fasting. In the early church this was the time new converts prepared for baptism. Historically, it became a time when people decided to give up something – often food – as a way of preparing themselves through fasting. Jesus fasted in times of preparation, in the Wilderness when he was tempted. John Wesley encouraged practicing regular times of fasting in order to draw closer to God.

The day before Ash Wednesday is known as Shrove Tuesday, Fat Tuesday, and Pancake Day. The tradition of pancakes, crepes, and cakes came about after Pope St. Gregory declared, "We abstain from flesh, meat, and from all things that come from flesh, as milk, cheese, and eggs." Thus, people started to use up those ingredients before Lent began. In some places, cleaning these ingredients out of the kitchen was supposed to relieve those working in kitchens so that they would have extra time to pray.

Now many choose to give something up for Lent and others take up a new discipline for this time. The point is to intentionally practice prayer and confession. Around 150 years before Pope St. Gregory's declaration, Pope Leo I preached a sermon that questioned the purpose of fasting and suggested that fasting be "adorned with mercy." (Donigian, George. A World Worth Saving, p 10) Maybe we need to both give up something that takes time and replace that time with acts of mercy.

I am excited about the resources that I am using this year for Lent. Kate Bowler and her team created free Lenten resources through grants available through the Duke Endowment and Eli Lily Foundation. This means that there are free daily Lenten guides, weekly discussion guide, and a sermon guide to help prompt me to go deeper as I prepare sermons for Lent. The title of this series is Bless the Lent We Actually Have.

Each week we will discuss how we are blessed even though we live in finite bodies and difficult situations. We will conclude each week with a special benediction.

I will also offer a group discussion on Tuesdays at Noon. The resources are free and can be found at <a href="https://katebowler.com/blessthislent/">https://katebowler.com/blessthislent/</a>. If you need a hard copy of the daily material, please contact the office.
